




Laurence Freeman is a Benedictine monk and the spiritual successor of John Main OSB. He is the Director of The World Community for Christian Meditation. Author, retreat leader and international speaker, Fr Laurence sees the contemplative as the essential dimension of all spirituality.

ITINERARY:

Daily meditation will be scheduled everyday before breakfast, during the Holy mass, and after dinner.

18OCT (Tue). LISBON.

Arrive in *Lisbon Airport*. After immigration and customs formalities, board your coach and check in at your hotel for accommodation. (D)

Remarks:

→ Standard hotel check in time is 2:00 p.m.

→ A coach will be arranged for the transfer of pilgrims to the hotel. Departure from Lisbon Airport will be at 12:00-12:30pm. For those who are arriving earlier or later in the afternoon, may take a taxi to the hotel or we can arrange for a private transfer.

19OCT (Wed). LISBON - FATIMA.

Breakfast followed by check-out. Meet your local guide at the hotel. Then, head for the Church of St. Anthony de Padua, built on the site where the saint was born. See the Saint's relics located in the crypt. Mass to be arranged for the group. Across is the Lisbon Cathedral where St. Anthony was baptized. Continue with your sightseeing tour of Lisbon. Stop at the Belem Tower – it is the city's most photographed landmark. Built in 1515 as a fortress to guard the entrance to Lisbon's harbor, the Belem Tower was the starting point for many of the voyages of discovery, and for the sailors it was the last sight of their homeland. It is a monument of Portugal's Age of Discovery. View the Jeronimus Monastery, the most impressive symbol of Portugal's power and wealth during the Age of Discovery. See the Moorish Citadel and the impressive Black Horse Square. After lunch, journey on to one of the world's greatest Marian pilgrimage centers - *Fatima*. Check in at your hotel for accommodation. Mass to be arranged in one of the chapels in the Fatima Sanctuary. After dinner, there will a meditation before proceeding to the Sanctuary for the 9:00 p.m. evening Rosary and Candlelight procession. (B,D)

20OCT (Thu). FATIMA.

In the morning, join the group meditation before breakfast. After, proceed to one of the chapels of the Sanctuary for the celebration of the Holy Mass. Then, meet your local guide for a tour of *Fatima*. Visit the Chapel of Apparition, the Basilica where you can find the tombs of the three seers: Francisco, Jacinta, and Sister Lucia, Aljustrel - home of Francisco and Jacinta, Lucia's house with the well where the Angel appeared a second time, Valinhos - site of Our Lady's 4th apparition, Loca do Cabeco - where the children received the first and the third visit of the "Angel of Peace," the Stations of the Cross composed of 14 little chapels, and the Parish Church. The rest of the day shall be free for private devotions and prayers. Spend time at the Sanctuary in the Cova da Iria. Meditate and pray at the Chapel of Apparitions, the very heart of the Sanctuary. A marble pillar marks the exact spot on which the Statue of Our Lady is placed. Before dinner, join the group meditation. After, join the Rosary and Candlelight procession. (B,D)

21OCT (Fri). FATIMA - SALAMANCA - BURGOS.

Meet the group in the morning for meditation. Then, proceed to one of the chapels in the Sanctuary for the celebration of the Holy Mass. Return to your hotel for breakfast followed by check out. Continue your journey toward the ancient town of *Salamanca*. Stop at the Plaza Mayor for lunch. Drive to *Burgos* for dinner and overnight accommodation. Join the evening group meditation before retiring to bed. (B,D)

22OCT (Sat). BURGOS - LOURDES.

Meet the group in the morning for meditation before breakfast. Check out of your hotel and walk to the Cathedral of St. Mary of Burgos for the Holy Mass. Spend some free time exploring the Cathedral which contains numerous architectural, sculptural, and pictorial treasures such as the Santísimo Cristo de Burgos, image of great devotional tradition; the tomb of El Cid and his wife Doña Jimena, his letter of Down payment and his

chest; and the Papamoscas, articulated statue that opens his mouth to give the chiming of the hours.

After lunch, depart for the town of **Lourdes**, where in 1858, the appearance of the Mother of God to the then 14-year old Bernadette Soubirous in the remote Grotto of Massabielle can be summarized in four words that evoke and amplify the Good News of the Gospels: **POVERTY, PRAYER, PENANCE, and CHURCH**. Check in at your hotel followed by dinner and then meditation. Catch the evening Rosary and Candlelight procession. **(B,D)**

23OCT (Sun). LOURDES.

Meet the group in the morning for meditation before breakfast. After, celebrate mass in one of the chapels of the Sanctuary. The rest of the day is free for private individual activities. Take time to explore the three superimposed churches built over the Grotto of Apparition, the Basilica of Immaculate Conception (Upper Basilica), the Crypt, and the Rosary Basilica. Spend time meditating and praying the Holy Rosary at the Grotto of Massabielle, the spot where Our Lady appeared to Bernadette and identified herself as, *"I am the Immaculate Conception."* The Sanctuaries and pools are always open and religious ceremonies are held every day: Masses, Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, Stations of the Cross, Blessed Sacrament Procession, and Blessing of the Sick. Group Meditation to be arranged before dinner. After, join the evening Rosary and Candlelight procession. **(B,D)**

24OCT (Mon). LOURDES - BORDEAUX - BONNEVAUX.

Celebrate an early morning Mass in one of the chapels of the *Lourdes Sanctuary*. Then, return to your hotel for breakfast and check out. Stop in **Bordeaux** for lunch. Continue your pilgrimage to **Bonnevaux**. Bonnevaux is the international meditation and retreat centre of The World Community for Christian Meditation (WCCM). Check in for your 3-night accommodation at the Bonnevaux Retreat Center, a place for peaceful transformation. A residential community lives in the spirit of the Rule of St Benedict together with volunteers from many parts of the world. Bonnevaux serves global peace and unity among all traditions through dialogue, silence and friendship. After dinner, enjoy the evening meditation together with rest of the residents of the Center. **(B,D)**

25-26OCT (Tue-Wed). BONNEVAUX.

Spend your 3-days stay at the Center for a contemplative retreat with daily morning and evening meditation. The beauty and peace of Bonnevaux's 65 hectares (160 acres) reflects the contemplative life lived there from its foundation as a Benedictine monastery in 1119 until the French revolution. The land has over 20 different habitats, some of which are of heritage value. The community see themselves as stewards of this fertile place. The central house is home to a residential community living in the spirit of St. Benedict. This core community includes oblates and long-term guests. Daily life is built on the spirit of silence within the monastic rhythm of prayer, work and study, hospitality and care for others. During the set times of prayer and meditation all other activities rest and move into silence. Join the activities of Bonnevaux organized under the supervision of l'Association Abbaye de Bonnevaux. On your last evening here at the Center, enjoy an evening of fellowship after dinner. **(B,L,D)**

27OCT (Thu). BONNEVAUX - CHARTRES - PARIS.

Morning meditation before breakfast. Check out of your hotel and depart for the medieval town of **Chartres**. On arrival, lunch at a local restaurant. Then, meet your local guide for a sightseeing tour before visiting the classic Gothic style *Cathedral of Our Lady of Chartres*, world famous for its architectural wonders and is probably the most complete and best preserved medieval Church in the western world. It houses the "Virgin's Veil" which according to the tradition would have been worn by Mary at the time of the birth of Christ. Celebrate the Holy Mass before leaving for Paris. On arrival, check in at your hotel for accommodation. Enjoy dinner at your hotel followed by an evening meditation. **(B,D)**

28OCT (Fri). PARIS.

Morning meditation before breakfast. Drive to Rue de Bac this morning where you will visit the Chapel of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal. It was here

where in 1830 our Lady appeared to St. Catherine Laboure and instructed her to have a medal made and all who wear it will receive great graces. Mass to be arranged for the group. Then, meet your local guide after the Mass. On with your Paris Discovery Tour... a perfect introduction to the city which includes most of its highlights: Sacre Coeur; Concorde Square; Trocadero Square; view of the Eiffel Tower; Champs Elysees; photo stop at the Arc de Triomphe; Madeleine; and the Opera. In the afternoon, visit the Louvre Museum, the world's largest art museum and a historic monument in Paris. End the day with a one-hour Bateaux Parisiens Cruise on the River Seine where you will have the opportunity to see the major historical buildings of Paris such as the Notre Dame de Cathedral; Louvre Museum. Dinner at a local restaurant before heading back to your hotel. End the night with a group meditation before retiring. **(B,D)**

29OCT (Sat). PARIS - PARIS CDG AIRPORT.

Early morning meditation before having a leisurely breakfast. Day is free until you are transferred to **Paris CDG Airport** for your flight back home or other onward destination. **(B)**

Remarks:

→ *Standard hotel check out time is 10 or 11:00 a.m.*
→ *A coach will be arranged for the transfer of pilgrims to the airport. Departure from the hotel will be at 1:00 p.m. For those who do not wish to wait for the scheduled transfer due to an earlier flight schedule, taxis may be arranged with the hotel concierge or we can arrange for a private transfer from the hotel to the airport.*
